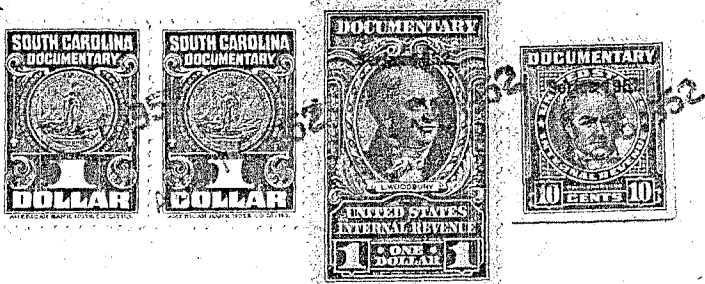

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Lee Plummer and Eliza Cummings

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, near the City limits of Greenville and lying on the South side of Anderson Road and being Lot No. 6 according to the plat of the property of Ellison G. Webster, Jr., and recorded in Plat Book O, page 43 in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Anderson Road at the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence N. 56-10 E. 58 feet along the Anderson Road to the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 5; thence with the line of Lot 5, S. 22-40 E. 102 feet to the rear joint corner of Lots 6 and 5; thence S. 56-10 W. 58 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence with the line of lot 7, N. 22-40 W. 102 feet to the beginning corner.
