

PARCEL 3: That certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the northeast side of the Laurens Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5 on plat of property of C.S. Putman recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book F, at page 240, and having according to said plat the following notes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of the Laurens Road, joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 34-12 E. 200 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence along the line of Lot 17, S. 53-15 E. 67 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence along line of Lot 6, S. 34-13 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Laurens Road; thence along said Laurens Road, N. 55-45 W. 67 feet to point of beginning.
