to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bonnie D. Medlock, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Dunklin Township, containing 9.3 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described according to a survey of the property of F. M. Davenport, Sr. Estate, prepared by C. C. Jones, Surveyor, July 1952, recorded in Plat Book BB at Pages 78 and 79, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the Old Augusta Road, in the East line of the 50 acres Home Place, at the corner of the parcel conveyed to F. Scott Davenport, Sr., and running thence along the center of the Old Augusta Road, the following courses: S. 12-17 E. 200 feet, S. 15-59 E. 135 feet, S. 22-56 E. 200 feet, S. 26-41 E. 325.3 feet, to an iron pin in the center of intersection of Old Augusta Road, and a County Road; thence along the center of the County Road, N. 57-17 E. 506 feet to a point in line of right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 25; thence N. 29-25 W. 1234 feet to an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the 50 acres Home Place tract; thence with said Home place tract, S. 61-35 W. 376 feet to the point of beginning.

This deed is executed in partition of the lands owned by F. M. Davenport, Sr. at the time of his death pursuant to the terms of his Last Will and Testament dated December 11, 1945, on file in the Office of the Probate Court in Apartment 600 at File 6. The grantor, Mrs. Brannon Davenport, joins in the execution of the deed as evidence that she has elected to take under the terms of said Will and to convey any right, title, or interest in the above described land to which she may be entitled.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
