to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Boyce Hendricks Crenshaw, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Pacific Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 321, Pleasant Valley, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P, page 114 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
