in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Irie Cowart, George Campbell and Luther Land, as Trustees of the Church of God of Prophecy, their successors in office and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Chicora Avenue, near the City of Greenville, known as lot No. 4, Block EE, on plat of Riverside Subdivision, made by P. H. Foster, Surveyor, October 1909, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 323, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Chicora Avenue, at the joint front corner of lots 3 and 4, Block EE, and running thence with line of lot 3, in an easterly direction 122.5 feet to an iron pin on the west side of the right-of-way of the C. K. & W. Railroad; thence with the railroad right-of-way in a southerly direction 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lot 5 in a westerly direction 122.1 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Chicora Avenue; thence with the east side of Chicora Avenue, N. 7-51 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
