

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that I, Glenn A. Jacobs of the City of Denver, County of Denver, State of Colorado, now in the Military Service of the United States and stationed at Donaldson Air Force Base, S.C., being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact, to act for me and on my behalf in any and all matters in which I may have an interest, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Sibyl F. Jacobs of Denver, Denver County, Colorado, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power to pledge, mortgage, or execute deeds of trust for, sell, transfer, assign, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any and all of my property, real, personal or mixed under such terms or conditions as she may deem proper, and to execute and deliver good and sufficient instruments for the accomplishment thereof; to collect, sue upon, compromise or adjust any claim, debt, bequest, devise, or inheritance in which I may now or hereinafter have an interest; to execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for household effects as authorized by law and Air Force Regulations, and to receive, endorse and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States, for whatever amount or account, and to give full discharge therefor; to pay, compromise, or otherwise discharge and secure releases from any obligation or claims against me; to deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker, or trust company any check, including the aforementioned checks drawn on the Treasurer of the United States, which may come into her hands as such attorney, and all monies, drafts, promissory notes, and other securities for money payable or belonging to me, and for that purpose to sign my name and endorse the same for deposit or collection, and from time to time withdraw any and all monies deposited with the aforesaid depositories, or any other depositories, now or hereafter having monies belonging to me, and for that purpose to draw checks in my name.

FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid attorney-in-fact to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorizations and I do expressly declare that the powers herein granted to my aforesaid attorney-in-fact shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinbefore specifically set forth, but rather shall be construed to broadly include and embrace full and unlimited power and authority to do and perform, on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity any and all other lawful acts or things which I could do if personally present; and I hereby ratify and confirm whatsoever my said attorney-in-fact shall and may do, by virtue hereof, in the premises.
