McBride and Lucy H. McBride, their heirs and assigns forever

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 12, according to a plat of Northside Gardens, plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1946, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "S", at page 17 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Bates Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 13, S. 54-56 W. 211 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 12, 13, 36 and 37; thence along the line of Lot No. 37, S. 34-48 E. 85 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Poppy Way; thence along the northwestern side of Poppy Way, N. 54-56 E. 207.7 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Bates Drive; thence along the southwestern side of Bates Drive, N. 32-43 W. 85 feet to the point of beginning, being a portion of the property conveyed to the grantors herein by deed of W. A. Bates dated January 22, 1932, which deed is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 162, at page 78. The above described property is subject to restrictive covenants of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 328, at page 22 and to the amended restrictions applicable to said property.

The above lot is subject to all right of ways, easements and restrictions of record affecting said property.

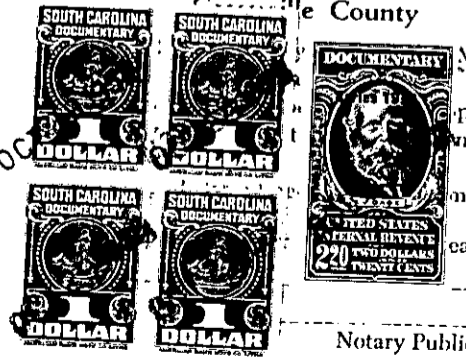
