BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Robin Hood Road at joint front corner of Lots 153 and 154 and running thence with the line of Lot 153 S. 71-50 W. 139.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-40 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-36 E. 155.8 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Robin Hodd Road, thence with West side of Robin Hood Road S. 19-10 E. 90 feet to the beginning point.
