presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. R. Alewine and Margaret
M. Alewine, their heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina located on the Northwest side of the Holliday's
Dam Road about one half of mile Northeast of Holliday's Dam contain-
ing one acre more or less and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at a corner in center of Holliday's Dam Road running
S 32-20 E through an iron pin twenty (20) feet from said corner and
along a line of land of F. L. Holliday two hundred and ten (210)
feet to an iron pin; thence S 62-55 W along a line of land of F.
L. Holliday two hundred and ten (210) feet to an iron pin; thence
N 32-20 W along a line of land of Amos Wooten two hundred and ten
(210) feet to a corner in the center of the Holliday's Dam Road
said line passing through an iron pin off set 23.2 feet from said
corner in center of Holliday's Dam Road; thence N 62-55 E down
the center of Holliday's Dam Road two hundred and ten (210) feet
