

to execute, deliver and cash checks drawn on my bank deposit or any bank deposit standing in my name; to invest and reinvest any money belonging to me which may come into her hands; to execute and deliver assignments, endorsements, deeds, mortgages, leases, contracts and other instruments in writing necessary or appropriate to the conduct of my business or affairs, or to the effectual delivery of any securities or other personal property, or to evidence the transfer of any real property or interest therein; to borrow money and to execute notes and give security therefor, including the power to extend any note or notes which may have been given or may be given by me; to employ agents, attorneys and counsel and generally to do and transact any and all business for me and in my name as fully as I might do if personally present and acting.

And I do ratify and approve all acts and things which my said attorney may do in the premises.

This power of attorney shall remain in force and effect until cancelled in writing upon the face hereof and upon the record hereof in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, should this power of attorney be recorded in that office, and this power of attorney or the record thereof in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, or any authenticated copy of either shall be the full and complete warrant and authority for any person whomsoever to deal with my said attorney in the premises.
