This contract made and entered into this day and date at Greenville, S. C. by and between Thomas J. Shular and Rosealee C. Shular.

W I T N E S S E T H:

First, that each of the parties hereto being man and wife, by reason of a marriage entered into between them on the 15th day of March, 1948 in the State of Georgia, have decided, on account of unhappy differences, that it is best for both parties that they live separate and apart in the future, and they do hereby release, and discharge each other from any and all obligations caused by the relation of husband and wife, that is to say, the said Thomas J. Shular does hereby release, ^{and} discharge the said Rosealee C. Shular from any and all obligations as a wife to him; that the said Rosealee C. Shular does hereby release and discharge the said Thomas J. Shular from any and all obligations by way of support, maintenance, contributions and attentions as a husband.

Second, it is further agreed that following this separation, neither party shall annoy, approach, visit or in any way interfere with the social relations of the other party, and that each shall be free to make their own choice as to residence, associates, and any other activities that either may desire.

Third, that the said Thomas J. Shular does hereby renounce and release any and all claims to inheritance as a heir at law of the said Rosealee C. Shular, including her estate should she survive her; and the said Rosealee C. Shular does hereby renounce, release, and relinquish ^{ish} forever any inheritance, including dower in real property should the said Thomas J. Shular ever acquire any, and the said Rosealee C. Shular, upon being privately and separately examined, does declare that without any dread or fear or coercion does hereby renounce, relinquish, release and forever quit-claim all her right, title and interest in and to any and all real estate which the said Thomas J. Shular might at any time in the future acquire,
