That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News-Piedmont Company, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is

THE LILLIAN N. CRAWFORD CLUB OF PRACTICAL NURSES, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.  
(401 North Calhoun St.)

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to promote, academic, scientific, and professional advancement among the members and to serve as a forum for the exchange of ideas and information on matters relating to Practical Nursing, and to serve the Community at large in times of need, and especially to aid the indigent sick and shut ins who need help, and to foster co-operation with other similar organizations.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

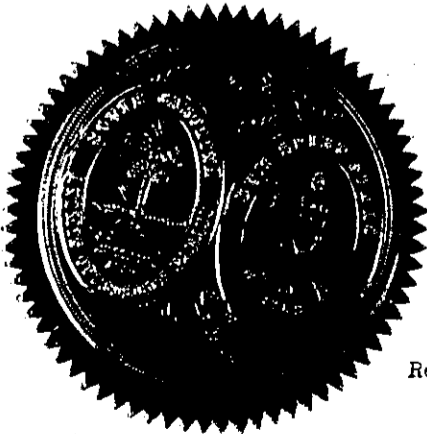

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 19th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two and in the one hundred and seventy-seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America.
