LaBoone,

in consideration of the premises and also in consideration of the ~~sum of~~ quit claim deed of the ~~xxxxxx~~
to one acre area as described below and other considerations,
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by Alvin Pack LaBoone
and Wilma LaBoone, and Addie LaBoone Smith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have remise, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these
LaBoone
presents do remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said Alvin Pack and Wilma LaBoone,
and Addie LaBoone Smith,
that property known as tracts No. 11 which my late father W. F. LaBoone left in
his estate, this property now consists of approximately 8 acres and is off the
Piedmont highway near Gantt Station, with the exception of the one acre area within
described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the line with lot 7 of the J.F.
Murrell property running South 55 - 40 East a distance of 253 feet to an iron
pin in the middle of the road. From this point North 33 - 35.5 East 139.8 feet
to an iron pin in the middle of said road. Thence north 55 - 40 West 353.2 feet
to an iron pin on the line with the J. F. Murrell property; thence South 0 - 45
East 123 feet to the point of beginning.
