All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 12 of a subdivision known as Woodland Hills according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in May, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at page 60, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern edge of Ridgewood Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 73-0 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence N. 17-0 W. 95 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 13; thence along the line of that lot, S. 73-0 W. 160 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of Ridgewood Drive; thence along the eastern edge of Ridgewood Drive, S. 17-0 E. 95 feet to the beginning corner; being one of the lots conveyed to me by Robert J.
