to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Robert R. Adams, his heirs and assigns, forever,

All those lots of land situate on the Northeast side of Boxwood Lane in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, S. C., and being shown as Lots 21 & 22 on a plat of Boxwood Manor, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "BB", Page 85, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Boxwood Lane at joint front corner of Lots 20 & 21 and running thence along the line of Lot 20 N. 60-52 E. 202.5 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Hemlock Drive; thence with the Southwest side of Hemlock Drive N. 26-50 W. 100.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Hemlock Drive N. 33-58 W. 101.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Hemlock Drive (the chord being N. 81-11 W. 72.6 feet) to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Hemlock Drive; thence with the Southeast side of Hemlock Drive S. 58-57 W. 100.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Hemlock Drive and Boxwood Lane (the chord being S. 14-55 W. 57.5 feet) to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Boxwood Lane; thence with the Northeast side of Boxwood Lane S. 29-08 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property that was owned by W. C. Cleveland at the time of his death on August 26, 1946, and this conveyance is made by the Grantors, as Executors under the will of W. C. Cleveland pursuant to the power and authority conferred on us by his will dated January 17, 1940, on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 518, File 29.
