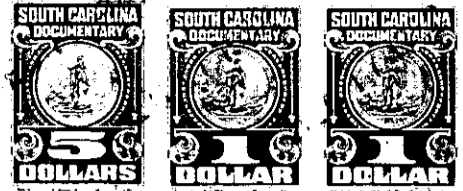
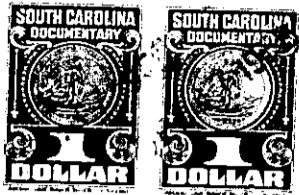

All that lot of land situate on the Northwest side of Woodland Way in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, S. C., and being shown as Lot No. 10 on a plat of Boxwood Manor, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "BB", Page 85, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Woodland Way at joint front corner of Lots 9 & 10 and running thence along the line of Lot 9 N. 29-08 W. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 11 S. 60-52 W. 131.5 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Hemlock Drive; thence with the East side of Hemlock Drive S. 11-53 E. 111.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Hemlock Drive S. 3-10 E. 100.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Hemlock Drive (the chord being S. 54-44 E. 19.8 feet) to an iron pin on the northern side of Woodland Way; thence with the northern side of Woodland Way N. 78-18 E. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Woodland Way N. 60-52 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property that was owned by W. C. Cleveland at the time of his death on August 26, 1946, and this conveyance is made by the Grantors, as Executors under the will of W. C. Cleveland pursuant to the power and authority conferred on us by his will dated January 17, 1940, on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 518, File 29.
