FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is JUDSON CROSSING USED CARS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is buy and sell automobiles and financing automobiles and other chattle goods.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars payable 20% down and balance one year from date of issuance of stock

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital is divided is Twenty five (25) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of December, 1952, at which a majority of all stock in value (any present or future) proxy, the following were elected directors:

Preston C. Temple and W. R. Sanders

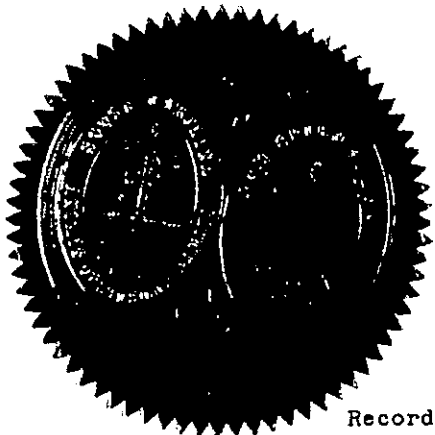

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and through public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the law of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office
