SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, the undersigned, William M Scott Jr.

, a legal resident of Greenville

County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, now  
in the military service as a Technical Sergeant, Serial Number

AF-14082276, in the United States Air Force, and temporarily re-  
siding at Camp Stoneman, California, have made, constituted and appointed,  
and by these presents do make constitute and appoint my mother,

Nancy E Scott, whose present address is Greenville, South

Carolina, my true and lawful attorney in fact and in my  
name, place, and stead, and for my use and benefit and as my act and deed,  
to

To purchase and mortgage a dwelling house and lot located at and described as  
follows;

A dwelling house on lot 328, and known and designated as 18 Pacific Ave,  
in the City of Greenville, South Carolina. And through said mortgage to borrow  
all monies necessary and proper to carry into effect the purchase of said house  
as my said attorney shall think fit; and act in relation to said purchase and  
mortgage as fully and effectually in all respects as I myself could do; I hereby  
ratify everything which my said attorney, under the power hereinbefore contained,  
shall do, or purport to do, in virtue of these presents.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney authority to do whatever is  
necessary to be done in and about the aforesaid business as fully as I  
could do if personally present, the above powers being the only powers  
herein granted, hereby ratifying all that my said attorney Nancy E Scott  
shall do or cause to be done by virtue of these  
presents.

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my  
said attorney by virtue of the powers herein granted, shall be binding  
on myself, my heirs, legal and personal representatives, and assigns,  
whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other  
revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or  
notice thereof shall have been received by my said attorney; and whether  
or not I, the grantor of this instrument, shall have been reported or listed  
either officially or otherwise, as "missing in action" as that phrase is  
used in military parlance, it being the intentment hereof that such status  
designation shall not bar my attorney from fully and completely exercising  
and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted,  
and that such report of "missing in action" shall neither constitute or  
be interpreted as constituting notice of my death nor operate to revoke  
this instrument.
