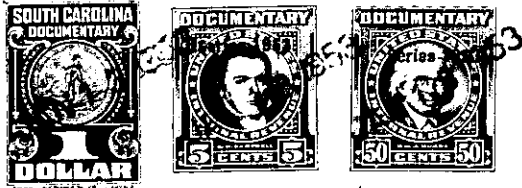

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, L. E. Morton  
of the County of Greenville,  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00)  
Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by N. I. White  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. I. White, his heirs and assigns  
**for ever,**

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, all those pieces, parcels, or lots of land being known and  
designated as parts of lots Numbers 9 and 10 in Section C of the Property of J. Ed  
Means, as shown on a Plat thereof recorded in the R. W. C. Office for Greenville  
County, South Carolina in Plat Book "J" at pages 186 and 187, and being more  
particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Eva Street in the center of lot number 9, which is  
exactly 70 feet from either of the front corners of said lot, and running thence  
with Eva Street 70 feet to the joint front corner of lots numbers 9 and 10; thence  
continuing with Eva Street 51.2 feet to the corner of Eva Street, and Alma Avenue;  
thence with Alma Avenue S. 65- 33 E. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Westerly  
direction across lot number 10 and half way across lot number 9 to an iron pin, being  
169 feet; thence N. 40-30 W. 105 feet to the point of beginning, and being the  
northern portion of lot number 10 and a portion of the northeastern part of lot  
number 9.

The above described land is a portion the same conveyed to me by  
J. Ed Means on the 17th day of  
April, 19 51, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
Greenville County, in Book 432 Page 520

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the  
said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said  
N. I. White, his  
Heirs and Assigns forever.
