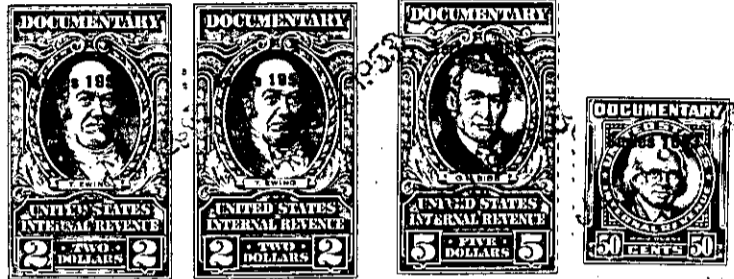
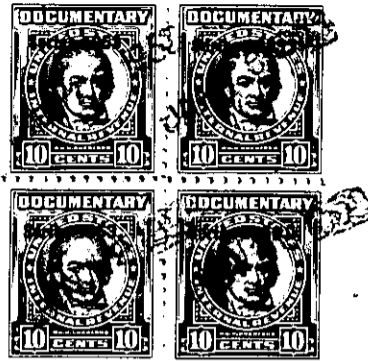

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Curtis G. Henderson, his heirs and Assigns:-

All that certain peice, parcel or tract of land located lying and being in the County of Greenville, O'Neil Township, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No 2 of the M. H. Fowler Estate lands, as shown on plat of the same made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated Oct. 9, 1936 and recorded in Plat Book I at page 124, R.M.C.
