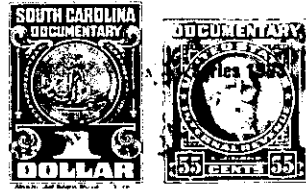

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Jack Kyle Pearson, of  
the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Four Hundred and Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by T.C. Bishop  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T.C. Bishop, his heirs and assigns  
forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being the northern half of Lot No. 95, on the  
eastern side of Hawthorne Lane on a plot of Land by the entry of  
Jane G. Hammond, near Greenville, South Carolina, made by Dalton &  
Neves, Engineers, in June, 1937, recorded in the R.M.O. Office for  
Greenville County, State aforesaid, in Plat Book No. 100, the  
northern portion of said Lot No. 95, being more particularly described  
as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Hawthorne Lane at the west corner of  
Lots Nos. 95 and 96 and running thence with front line of said  
Lots E. 38-15 E. 356.5 feet to the rear line of said Lots; thence  
S. 63-50E. 30 feet to a point at the rear line of Lot No. 95;  
thence in an westerly direction 358.4 feet to a point on Hawthorne  
Lane; thence with Hawthorne Lane in a northwesterly direction 21 feet  
to the point of beginning.

The intention of this deed is to convey the northern half  
of Lot No. 95 of Lanley Heights.
