NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN by these presents that I, Thomas James Bennett, of Greenville, South Carolina, hereby appoint my wife, Barbara Drake Bennett of Greenville, South Carolina, my attorney for me and in my name and on my behalf to do and execute all or any act, deed and thing, as fully as I might or could do if personally present.

Such as to execute, acknowledge, and cause to be recorded any and all instruments which it may be necessary or desirable for me to execute including contracts of sale conveying the title to any property owned by me or in which I have any interest, present or contingent.

Such as to surrender or cash any government bonds, or other bonds, that I do now have or may hereafter acquire, and to use the proceeds as she may deem necessary.

Such as to sell all or any part of any goods, wares, merchandise, and stock in trade as now or at any time hereafter I may have and possess on such terms and such accounts, and at such time, as my attorney may deem best, given unto my said attorney full power to make sales by herself or by her agents.
