J. Meekins and Crebell Meekins, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., on the southeast side of McAlister Road, shown as Lot 18 on plat of Greenacre Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "BB", Page 25, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

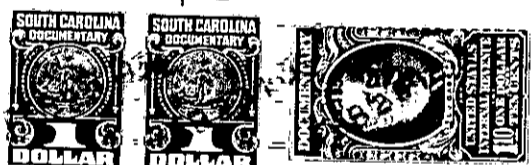
