All that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Greenville Township, on the western side of Palm Street, being shown as Lot No. 16 on plat of property of Sumlar Hall, made by Pickell & Pickell in May 1950, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
