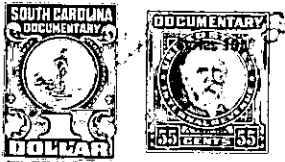

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

grantee, H. H. Kelloy, His Heirs and Assigns forever,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, about one mile north from Chick Springs, lying east from the St. Mary Road, being bounded on the northern and eastern sides by other lands of myself, on the southern side by lot of Robert Batson and on the western side by other property of myself and lot of H. H. Kelley, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed from V. W. Crowder February 2nd 1926, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 106 at page 383, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on the H. H. Kelloy line and joint corner of Robert Batson' and the lot being conveyed, and runs thence with the Batson line, S. 48-00 E. 305.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-30 E. 155.8 feet to an iron pin on the Mack Ayers Estate line; thence N. 48-00 W. 305.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 65-30 W. 155.8 feet to the beginning corner, containing One (1) acre, more or less.
