

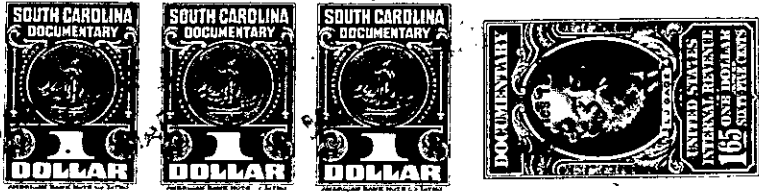

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 74 of the Property of Central Development Corporation according to a plat of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at Pages 22-23, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of Coventry Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 73 and 74 and running thence S 86-45 E 200 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 73 and 74; thence N 07-41 E 80.2 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 74 and 75; thence N 86-45 W 206.1 feet to a point on the Eastern side of Coventry Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 74 and 75; thence with the Eastern side of Coventry Lane S 03-15 W 80 feet to the point of beginning.
