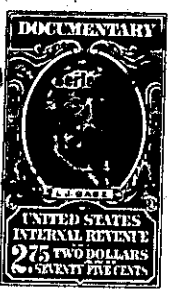
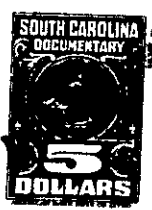

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Fred C. Foster and Ethel R. Foster

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina Lying on the west side of the Whitehorse Road and bounded by lands of J.H. Hannon and S.I. Coleman and other lands of Grantors and Containing Nine and 9/10 Acres, more or less, and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at a point in the White-horse Road at Hannon's corner, marked by iron pin on bank of road and running thence N. 66-30 W. 1300 feet to iron pin on Coleman's line; thence S. 24-30 W. 375 feet to iron pin; thence S.70-50 E. 1383 feet to iron pin in west edge of road; thence N. 8-47 E. 272.4 feet to beginning.
