LOT NO. 73 - BLOCK F: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Corinne Drive at the joint corner of Lot No. 70, and running thence with said lot, N. 56-37 E. 210.8 feet to an iron pin in rear corner of Lot No. 72; thence with the rear line of said lot, N. 32-07 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 74; thence with the line of said lot, S. 56-37 W. 209.1 feet to an iron pin in the Eastern side of Corinne Drive; thence with said Drive, S. 31-13 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

LOT NO. 74 - BLOCK F: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Corinne Drive, at joint front corner of Lot No. 73, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 56-37 E. 209.1 feet to rear corner of Lot No. 75; thence with the line of said lot, N. 32-07 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 77; thence with the line of said lot, S. 56-37 W. 207.5 feet to an iron pin in the Eastern side of Corinne Drive; thence with said Drive, S. 31-13 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
