Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, Lowell H. Tankersley, James B. Tankersley and Posey D. Tankersley

in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 - - - - (\$2,000.00) - - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jesse Mullinax and Bertha Mullinax, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the west side of the Middle Saluda River, in Cleveland Township, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 15.51 acres, more or less, according to plat of property of Jesse and Bertha Mullinax, made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, December 1952, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west bank of the Middle Saluda River at the corner of the Hart Property and running thence along line of Hart Property crossing the Jones Gap road, S. 37-30 W. 710 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 43 W. 859 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-45 E. 375 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 29-30 E. 264 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-30 E. 700 feet crossing the Jones Gap Road to a Birch on the west bank of the Middle Saluda river; thence along the same course 20 feet, more or less to a point in the center of the Middle Saluda River; thence following the meanders of the said river as the traverse line 700 feet more or less; thence S. 37-30 W. 20 feet, more or less, to the beginning point.

The above described land is a portion of the 704 acre tract conveyed to the grantors herein by deed of William G. Oldsmith, Jr., dated July 17th, 1952, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 468, Page 222.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

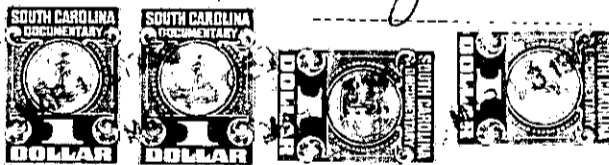
