"All those two certain lots, tracts or parcels of land situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, better known and designated as Lots No. 1 and 2, Sec. D, on a plat of property known as Woodville Heights made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, December 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at pages 14 and 15. This being the same property conveyed to A. H. Tucker and Mary C. Tucker, by H. H. Willis, by deed dated April 15, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 293, page 100, also,

"All those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots 1 and 2, in Section A, on a plat of property of Alice M. and H. H. Willis, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at pages 150 and 151. This property being the same deeded to A. H. Tucker and Mary C. Tucker by Alice M. Willis and H. H. Willis, by deed dated April 15, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 293, page 95, also,

"All that certain strip, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in West Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at the intersection of the dividing line between property of A. H. Tucker and property of R. D. and Maryann Phillips, if projected westwardly, with the easterly property line of Lois Avenue, said point of beginning being one hundred thirty-two and six-tenths (132.6) feet northwardly measured along said last mentioned street line) from the intersection of the north property line of Liberty Street (unopened) with said easterly property line of Lois Avenue; and running thence northwardly, along said easterly property line of Lois Avenue, a distance of one hundred forty (140) feet, more or less, to corner of Southern Railway Company property; thence eastwardly, at a right angle to last mentioned course, a distance of thirteen (13) feet, more or less, to the northwesterly corner of property of A.
