## CONTRACT

This indenture made this // day of March 1953 by and between G. A. ROBERTS of Route # 1, Simpsonville, South Carolina, First Party, and GREEWILLE PETROLEUM COMPANY, Greenville, South Carolina, Second Party.

## MITNESSETH

That in consideration of the covenant and agreements of the Second Party hereinafter set forth, said First Party hereby agrees and bloos himself to buy and sell only the petroleum products marketed by Second Party for a period of ten (10) years, specifically defined as from the 14th day of Farch 1953 until the day of March 1th, 1963.

- Party of Second fart agrees to loan to farty of first Part the following equipment for use in operation of service station:

  - 1 1000 gal. T. G. Tank
  - 2 550 gal. U. G. Tanks
  - 1 g H. P. Air Compressor
  - 1 36 Road Sign
  - l l gal. Stroke Pump
- 2. Party of Second Part also agrees to surface treat the drivewry at aforementioned 3. A. Roberts! Grocery are Director.
- 3. Party of Second Part agrees to sell the Party of First Fort petroleum products at its posted tankwason price for case at tire of delivery.

In consideration of the foregoing, the Party of the First Fart covenants and agrees as follows:

- A. That during the term of contract he will pay all convert and special taxes and assessments that may be levied in assessed avainst said premises and/or property owned by him located therean.
- That all buildings, structures, tanks, bumos, remain; make and other equipment placed upon the premises by Second Farty or by third persons acting under arrangement with Cooper Platy, whether or not embedded in the soil or affixed to the relaty, small remain the sole property of Cooper Party and at the exploration the contract by lapse of time or otherwise, said Cooper Party about have and is hereby given the right at any wire, with a courty (30) days after such termination, to onter doon are recovered and premises, any equipment by it at any wire placed ther on.
- C. That he will pay for all mater and plectricity used at advice station.
- D. That the Second Party can in no way be take rempositive or liable for any damage resulting from fire, explosion, or pollution resulting from petroleum products that the First Party was or inventory or sells, and that Second Party is not responsible for any losses due to mechanical failures of equipment.
- In the event of First Party's selling or assigning his property, this contract shall be deemed valid and binding to the ever he may sell or assign.
- F. That, unless either party serves written notice by registered mail thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of this contract, it shall continue in force from year to year.
