

receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the undersigned do hereby consent to The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina closing the portion of said alley above described, to-wit, that portion of said alley extending from the north side of North Laurens Street in a westerly direction a distance of 62-1/2 feet and do hereby relinquish and release unto the said Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina any and all interest in, title to, or rights, privileges or claims of every kind and description whatsoever in and to or in connection with the portion of said alley to be closed as aforesaid and do further agree and consent that the remaining portion of said alley in question shall be constituted, considered and used as a public alley of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and do hereby relinquish and convey to the City of Greenville, South Carolina such interest in and title or right to said portion of said alley to the City of Greenville, South Carolina for the purpose of constituting the remaining portion of said alley as a public alley. It being the intention of the undersigned by this instrument to consent to the closing by The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina of the portion of said alley above described and for the further purpose of consenting to the remaining portion of said alley being constituted a public alley and to that end to hereby relinquish and release to the City of Greenville, South Carolina any and all interest that we or any of us may have in the same.
