

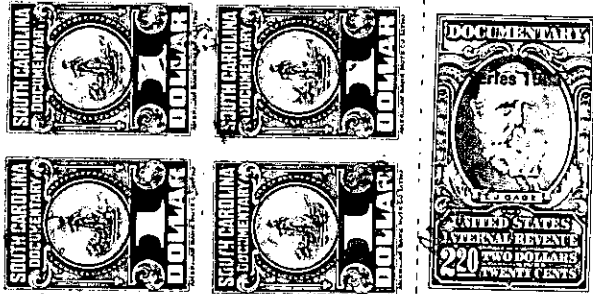

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clyde Stokes, all that piece parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds BEGINNING at a Poplar and running N 40½ W 20.00 Ch to a large rock; thence S 61½ W 10.00 Ch to a large stone in the branch; thence down the Meadows of said branch 10.10 to a small Poplar and stone; thence S 31½ W 9.77 to a stone; thence S 15½ E 89 links to a stone; thence S 48 W 6.68 to a stone; thence S 13E 18.05 to small pine, thence N 72½ E 7.66 to a sweet gum; thence N 81 E 2.11 to a stone; thence N 75 E 4.16 to stone; thence N 9½ W 9.00 a dead Hickory on the branch; thence up the branch with the Meadows to the beginning corner and containing Seventy Four and one fourth acres more or less.

ALSO all that other lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid on the headwaters of the Middle Tyger River containing Fourty Five acres more or less, BEGINNING on a Chestnut and running thence E 27.50 to a Poplar; thence S 20 W 25.00 to a Chestnut; thence S 57 E to a Poplar; thence to the beginning corner, this is the same land left by G.A.
