WHEREAS, in July of 1924 J. T. Chiles, Mary M. Chiles and R. L. Smith entered into an agreement whereby they dedicated a proposed street lying between tracts Nos. 3 and 4 of the Rutledge Farms, plat of which is recorded in Plat Book E at Page 155, and,

WHEREAS, said dedication has never been accepted by the public, and,

WHEREAS, said proposed street is not now being maintained and has never been maintained by the City of Greenville, and,

WHEREAS, there is no public necessity for said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the City of Greenville does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the School District of Greenville County No. 520 any right, title and interest which it might have in the aforementioned proposed public street and does hereby abandon and renounce any right to open said street as a public street.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises above mentioned unto the grantee, its successors and assigns forever.
