of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northwesterly side of U. S. Highway No. 25 (formerly known as Buncombe Road) near Travelers Rest, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 1, according to plat of the property of M. M. Tate estate, prepared by J. C. Hill, Registered Surveyor, dated March 7, 1953, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwesterly side of U. S. Highway No. 25 at joint front corner of property of M. M. Tate and Peterson; thence N. 37-45 W. 549.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78-30 E. 102.6 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the joint line of those lots, S. 37-45 E. 508.4 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on the Northwesterly side of U. S. Highway No. 25, thence along said highway, S. 51-30 W. 92 feet to an iron pin at joint corner of properties of Tate and Peterson, the point of beginning.
