(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Kenneth P. Nash and Frank L. Nash,  
their heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, containing Sixty Seven (67) acres, more or less,  
same being a part of the L. M. Nash old Home Place, bounded by lands  
now owned by the James M. Richardson estate, Mrs. M. O. McGee, William  
Abercrombie and by Raburns Creek, and having the following metes and  
bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone, the James M. Richardson corner, and  
running thence N. 72 3/4 E. 38.30 chs. along the Richardson line, to  
center of Raburns Creek; thence down said Creek, 25.90 chs, southwester-  
ly, to a point where spring branch intersects Raburns Creek; thence up  
said branch, northwesterly, to point in center of spring; thence S. 42 3/4
