Brown,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 31 on plat of Glenwood Acres, as shown on plat thereof recorded in plat book A7 page 183 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to a recent survey made by James M. Beeson, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Trenholm Road, the joint corner of lots Nos. 30 & 31, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 89-57 W. 26.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0-03 W. 124.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-23 E. 208.5 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Trenholm Road; thence with the west side of said road N. 0-03 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

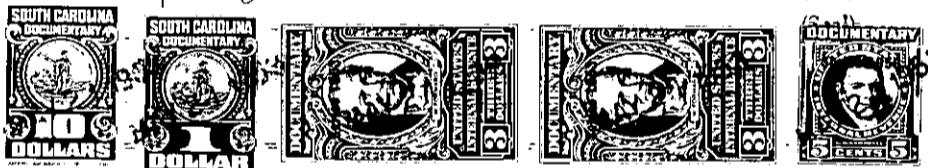
