did on the 19th. day of May, 19 53, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is RADIO AND ELECTRIC CO., INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C. (1703 Augusta Street)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is Sales and service of equipment and appliances including, but not limited to, radios, television, air conditioning, heating, washing, cooking and refrigerator equipment, ironers, vacuum cleaners, all other home appliances or accessories; and to sell the component parts thereof. To service and install any of the above, whether through sales by petitioner or through contracts with other dealers.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twelve Thousand Six Hundred (\$12,600.00) Dollars payable all subscribed and paid in.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred Twenty Six (126) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 11th. day of April, 19 53, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Joe T. Baty and S. W. McCandless

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, S. W. McCandless ; as Vice-President, Mary W. Baty ; as Secretary, Mary G. McCandless ; as Treasurer, Joe T. Baty

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Observer a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
