ALL That certain piece, parcel or strip of land, located in the City of Greenville, S. C., and being designated as Liberty Lane on a plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in March, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "Z", Page 199, said Lane having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin at the easterly corner of the intersection of Liberty Lane and Greenacre Road, which iron pin is located 300.4 feet in a southwesterly direction from the southerly corner of the intersection of Greenacre Road and Laurens Road, this iron pin also being shown as the westerly corner of the lot on the plat of McMahan and Clary as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "CC", Page 45, and running thence S. 55-31 E. along the rear line of the McMahan and Clary lot through the property of James W. Curdts, Trustee, and continuing along the rear of the property of Cannon, et al., 773 feet, more or less, to the northwesterly side of the By-Pass Highway connecting Laurens Road and Augusta Road; thence along the northwesterly side of said By-Pass in a southwesterly direction 50 feet, more or less; thence N. 55-31 W. 733 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the southeasterly side of Greenacre Road; thence along the southeasterly side of Greenacre Road N. 31-30 E. 50.07 feet to the point of beginning. It is the intention of this deed to convey to the grantee herein a street 50 feet in width which is parallel to Laurens Road, located as shown on the plat in Plat Book "Z", Page 199, and extended beyond the bounds of said plat in a straight line to said By-Pass, said property to be used as a public thoroughfare.
