(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Olive D. Bruce her heirs, and assigns forever that certain lot of land in Greenville County, S.C., which was deeded to me, Emma McClure, by J.G. Hutchison, Albert Dill, A.B. Dill, Olive D. Bruce, nieces, Lockhart, and recorded in Vol. 11 - Page 557 - May 25, 1911, in Greenville County, S.C. which is described on my deed as following - Beginning on a stone Sudduths Corner and runs thence S $8\frac{3}{4}$ W - 15.75 to stake in river thence S $45\frac{1}{4}$ E - 9.70 to an ash stump in the edge of river thence from a stake on opposite bank of river N. 65 E - 8.95 to a stone thence N $35\frac{1}{4}$ W - 22.75 to beginning Corner. This being a part of lands willed or deeded by James Henson to his daughter Mariam Dill, bounded by lands of Rube Sudduth estate, lot no. 5 and others. This said lot of lands contains (16.84) acres more or less.
