FOR and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the undersigned, Henry P. Willimon, in hand paid by Blackinton Mills, Inc., the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, Henry P. Willimon, do hereby grant unto Blackinton Mills, Inc., its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon,

That tract of land situate in Gantt Township, Greenville County, S. C., bounded on the northwest by property of Blackinton Mills, Inc., on the northeast by Reedy River and on the south and southwest by other property of the grantor,

And to construct and maintain, in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner, a four inch water pipe line, air vents, blowoff connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, with the right at all times to enter upon said premises, for the purpose of inspecting said water line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all trees and other obstructions that may in anyway endanger or interfere with the proper operation of same.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way to be used under this contract, is to commence at the southeast edge of the property of Blackinton Mills, Inc., under or near the southern approach to the bridge crossing Reedy River and running thence in a southeasterly direction approximately 425 feet to a point in the center of said Reedy River, all being shown by plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1953, and the grantee shall have a right to use a strip of land ten (10) feet in width across said premises only during the installation
