I, Sibyl F. Jacobs, now temporarily residing in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Ralph E. Styles as my attorney-in-fact with full power and authority to perform all acts hereinafter designated.

The said Ralph E. Styles is hereby authorized to take possession of one 1952 green Ford Tudor, 1952 license D 295227, motor No. B 2DL-121250; to drive the same from the State of South Carolina to the Brooklyn, New York, Port of Embarkation; and to deliver the same to the Port Transportation Officer, POE, New York, whose address is First Avenue and 58th Street, Brooklyn, New York, it being understood that the Transportation Officer will transport said car to the address of 1st Lt. Glenn A. Jacobs.

This Power of Attorney is specifically limited to the authority stated in the preceding paragraph and shall cease and terminate upon delivery of said car to the Port Transportation Officer.

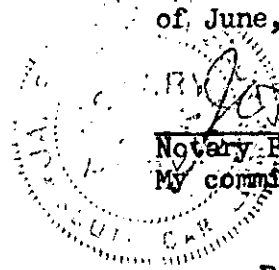
