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Know all men by these presents, that I, Howard Basco  
Roach, a legal resident of the

State of South Carolina, United States of America  
now a member of the armed forces of the United States to  
wit:- the United States Marine Corps, (Service Number  
(5757465)), anticipating that a Power of Attorney  
be useful in certain circumstances have made, constituted,  
and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute,  
and appoint, my wife, Patricia Ann Roach  
whose address is now 20 Harvley Street, Greenville, South Carolina,  
my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage, and conduct  
all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose for  
me, and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use and  
benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and execute or to  
concur with persons jointly interested with myself there-  
in in the doing or executing of all or any of the following  
acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:-

- (1) To buy, receive, accept, or otherwise acquire; to sell,  
convey, mortgage, hypothecate, quit claim, or otherwise  
encumber or dispose of; or to contract or agree for the  
acquisition, disposal, or encumbrance of: any property  
whatsoever, or any custody, possession, interest, or right  
therein, upon such terms as my said attorney shall think  
proper;
- (2) To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, or use,  
or otherwise manage any or all of my property or any in-  
terest therein; to eject, remove, or relieve tenants or  
other persons from, and recover possession of, such pro-  
perty by all lawful means; and to maintain, protect,  
preserve, insure, remove, store, transport, repair,  
rebuild, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof;
- (3) To make, do, and transact any and all kind of business  
of what nature and kind soever, including the receipt,  
recovery, collection, payment, compromise, settlement,
