All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 8-AB, on the west side of Monroe Street, being known and designated as the northern half of Lot No. 23 of a subdivision known as Marshall's Addition to the City of Greenville as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book EEE, at page 658, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
