BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast intersection of Twin Brook Drive (formerly Drayton Drive) and Carmel Street, and running thence with Carmel Street, N. 56-37 E. 185 feet to iron pin; thence N. 26-16 W. 89.8 feet to iron pin, rear corner of lot 140; thence with line of said lot, S. 59-34 W. 182.3 feet to iron pin in the Northeast side of Twin Brook Drive; thence with said Drive, S. 30-26 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions:

1. That this property shall be used for residential purposes only.
2. No house shall be constructed on said premises at a cost of less than \$10,000.00
3. The lot described above shall not be recut or resubdivided
4. Any construction on this lot shall be set back a total of 50 feet from the front lot line.
