Should a deceased beneficiary leave no surviving children, then his or her portion of this trust shall remain in the trust corpus and be divided among his or her brothers and sisters.

And I, F. A. Lawton, Jr., as Trustee, hereby signify my acceptance of this trust, and do hereby covenant and agree to, and with the beneficiaries to faithfully discharge and execute the same according to the true intent and meaning of these presents.
