All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 7, Section C of a subdivision known as Croftstone Acres, and having, according to a plat thereof, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at pages 78 and 79, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Wedgewood Avenue, which iron pin is 310 feet in a western direction from the southwestern intersection of Wedgewood Avenue and Broughton Drive and running thence, S. 11-00 E. 44.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-43 W. 42.8 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Wedgewood Avenue; thence along the southern side of Wedgewood Avenue, N. 63-10 E. 8.6 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
