Greenville County, South Carolina, its successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown on a plat of the property of R. W. Jones, the same being made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, during June 1947, and having according thereto the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeastern corner of the intersection of White Horse Road and an unnamed street, said pin being 347.5 feet South of the intersection of said White Horse Road and a Country Road, and running thence along said unnamed street N. 88-02 E. 200 feet to a point; thence N. 3-32 W. 1 foot to a point; thence along a new line S. 88-02 W. 200 feet to a point on the White Horse Road; thence along said Road S. 3-32 E. 1 foot to the point of beginning, and being the Southern portion of Lot # 1 according to said plat.
