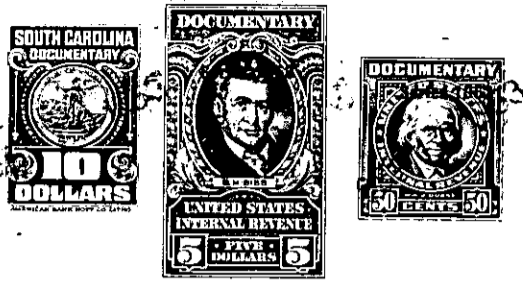

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 81 of a sub-division for Ray E. McAlister, Travelers Rest, South Carolina, a plat of which was made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated October 16, 1948, and revised February 24, 1949, and January 21, 1952, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book at page and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
