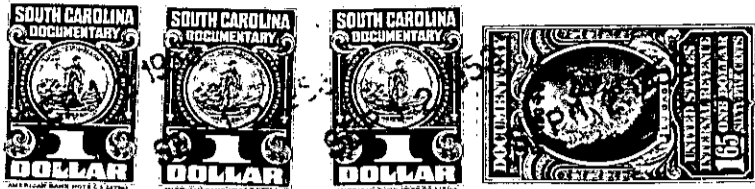

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That We, William D. Aiken, and Sybol S. Aiken of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Charles L. Allen, and Elizabeth T. Allen, their (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles L. Allen, and Elizabeth T. Allen, their heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the White Horse Road, known and designated as Lot No. 33 of Camilla Park Subdivision as shown on Map No. 2 of same made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, December, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book M at page 85, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of White Horse Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 33; thence with White Horse Road N. 8-16 E. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80-44 E. 199.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-16 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-44 W. 198.4 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the restrictions contained in deed from Mason Riddle to grantors.
